EIT Manufacturing 2024 Calls for Proposals

- ☐ The Calls are opened to any legal entity, regardless of its place of establishment, including legal entities from non-associated third countries or international organisations.
- ☐ The proposals should contribute to the Strategic Objectives of EIT Manufacturing.
 - Put people at the center of manufacturing.
 - Accelerate green manufacturing.
 - Foster sovereignty and competitiveness.
- ☐ The proposals should be aligned with the conditions laid in the Horizon Europe Regulation.





Activities

- The Call 2024 allows for 12 & 18 Month activity proposals. Activities should reflect Strategic Objectives of EIT Manufacturing and the Knowledge Triangle Integration approach.
- For the 18 Month activities, tangible outputs are expected to be created already in the first year (e.g. contribution to KPIs, substantiated go-tomarket results, financial sustainability, etc.)
- A monitoring of activities will be performed by EIT Manufacturing in order to thoroughly assess the activities performance.

- Education
- RIS (Regional Innovation Scheme)

Proposals must contribute to one of the specific Call Topics & Thematics.

Consortia Composition & Eligibility Criteria

The consortium shall be composed by at least 3 legal entities independent from each other and each established in a different country.

The consortium must include entities geographically based in at least two different EIT Manufacturing CLCs.

Depending on the Call Area, there are specific roles to be covered within the Consortium (for more details, please refer to the Call Guidelines).



Partnerships

- All entities of selected proposals will have to become an Associate Partner (and pay the related annual fee).
- Non-Partner organizations can get involved by submitting an Expression of Interest to participate in the Call.
- The following number of Linked Third Parties of a Core Partner may receive funding:
 - Partners being large enterprises, research institutes and universities: 5
 - Partners being mid-sized companies: 2



Funding considerations

- Funding cap for all organizations participating in the Call (i.e. EIT Manufacturing Core Partner including its Linked Third Parties (LTPs), Associate Partner, non-Partner organization) is € 1,500,000.
- Innovation Activities: project teams have to provide own contributions to cofund 30% (in case of 12-Month) or 40% (in case of 18-Month) of the total eligible KAVA costs of the activity.
- Education Activities: A co-funding of 30% is applicable only to proposals under the "Engage Society & Pupils" segment. NB: while co-funding is not required for the other segments, it will be positively evaluated.
- RIS Activities: The proposal under Topic 1 are not required to co-fund their activities, however, co-funding will be positively evaluated. For proposals under topic 2, the co-funding rate is 30%.





Financial Sustainability

Through the **Services Agreement,** EIT Manufacturing aims to generate a RoI for the Activities it funds, in order to gradually become financially independent from EIT funding and secure its ability to continue supporting European manufacturing organisations in the long term.

The Services Agreement is specific to the Call Area. The EIT Manufacturing Call 2024 for Innovation & RIS Proposals share the same mechanism and conditions, while, the EIT Manufacturing Call 2024 for Education proposals, encompasses two types of Services Agreements to manage commercialization and revenues:

- Digital Content
- Revenue Shares
