The CFO will be supported by an experienced and committed team.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Financial Strategy and Planning:

- Collaborate with the Management Team to create long-term financial plans, forecasts, and budgets that support the business planning, expansion, and innovation.

2. Financial Management:

- Oversee cash flow management, optimizing working capital while managing financial risk.

- Proficiency in financial modelling, analysis, and reporting tools.
- Exceptional leadership skills with the ability to motivate and mentor a diverse team.
- Excellent communication and presentation skills, with the ability to convey complex financial concepts to non-financial stakeholders.
- French language is necessary.
