



Request for Proposal

Freelancer media production support for EIT Community booth at SLUSH and side-event, Helsinki

1. Context

EIT Manufacturing is focused on promoting entrepreneurship, innovation, and education in the domain of Manufacturing. EIT Manufacturing brings together leading organisations along the entire value chain from smaller companies to larger industry, excellent academic and research institutions, as well as public sector organisations, to promote the transformation of manufacturing towards the digital economy, towards the circular economy and the decarbonization of industry, by removing barriers to innovation, promoting talent and education, leveraging enabling technologies and exploiting big data.

EIT Manufacturing Central gGmbH is a non-profit limited liability company under German law (Register No HRB 99846, Amtsgericht Darmstadt) created in 2019 responsible for EIT Manufacturing activities in Germany, Poland, Belgium, Netherlands, Luxembourg, Ireland and Ukraine.

For the following request EIT Manufacturing works on behalf of the **European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT)** and within the EIT for the **EIT Community**.

The **EIT** is an EU body created by the European Union in 2008 to strengthen Europe's ability to innovate. The EIT is an integral part of Horizon Europe, the EU's Framework Programme for Research and Innovation.

The EIT Community is a collaborative network comprising the European Institute of Innovation and Technology's (EIT) long-term partnerships, known as Knowledge and Innovation Communities (KICs). These KICs are dedicated to driving systemic change in Europe and beyond, focusing on key areas such as climate change, energy, health, food, manufacturing, raw materials, digitalisation, urban mobility, culture and creativity. By harnessing the collective expertise of the KICs, the EIT Community initiatives power innovation, entrepreneurship and creativity.

The EIT Community established an event series called **INNOVEIT**. The following request is supposed to strengthen overall key message of INNOVEIT, which is: Join Europe's largest innovation ecosystem.

2. Description

The Slush Event (19 to 21 November 2024) is a startup and tech event held annually in Helsinki, Finland. SLUSH facilitates meetings between the founders of startups and investors such as venture capitalists, accomplished with events such as matchmaking and pitching competitions. SLUSH aims to build a worldwide startup community.





At Slush three event components are planned:

- 19 November 2024: Side event (separate location in the city center of Helsinki, Meeting Park OASIS), 5 hour event including lunch
- 20 21 November 2024: Booth at Slush (40 sqm), with counter, 4-5 start-up booths, a networking area, and a space for the EIT Community initiatives and KICs
- Potentially: An event (breakfast?) at the booth

Under the following link you will get an impression of the SLUSH.

This RFP aims to collect offers

- 1. for a videographer, as well as
- 2. a photographer (who can support the videographer if necessary)

both available from 18 November 2024 until 20 (possibly 21) November 2024 at SLUSH in Helsinki at the INNOVEIT booth/side event.

The supplier must have experience in producing content for international events, specifically for European-wide initiatives. We are looking for a company that understands the nuances and requirements of working within the European context and can effectively communicate the achievements and contributions of the EIT Community. The budget should not exceed the amount of $12.000 \in$ for the video production at the side event on 19 November. If the other options are chosen, the budget in total should not exceed a total of $18.000 \in$.

3. Deliverables

The onsite two person-team plus the after-production team need to deliver the following:

- Main Video: The main video should feature a personal introduction by a representative from the EIT, highlighting the importance and key moments of the SLUSH / INNOVEIT event including potential messages from participating initiatives, start-ups etc.. It should capture the essence of the event and answer key communicative questions. Length: Approximately 2–3 minutes. Deadlines: Completed 3–6 days after the event. Export Formats: 16:9, 1:1.
- Interview Snippets: Detailed versions of the interviews conducted, including statements that may not have been included in the main video. Delivery: To be completed after the main video Export Formats: 16:9, 1:1.
- Event Photography: Description: A photographer should take reportage-style photos of the event, suitable for social media, press releases, and post-event reporting. Same-Day Photos: Description: Provide 10 event photos by the evening of each event day (via download link). Delivery: 50 photos within 3–6 days after the event
- **Optional (1)**: Second Video at SLUSH highlighting the EIT participation at SLUSH on 20 November and focusing on the AI Community and participating start-ups at SLUSH.

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• Optional (2): EIT Success Interviews: Description: Conduct interviews with 3-4 individuals from the EIT Community on the morning of the side event. These interviews will highlight the success stories and impact of the European Institute for Technology (EIT). The videos will be suitable for platforms like YouTube or LinkedIn. Content: Each video should feature one individual and may include supplementary photos and graphics provided by the interviewees or the EIT.

Please include the following positions in your offer:

- Preparation for production
- Shooting preparation arrival & departure logistics
- One or two production days in Helsinki
- Post-production of videos / post-production of photos
- Music licenses (optional)

5. Proposal submission procedure

Please send your proposal to <u>central@eitmanufacturing.eu</u> by 16 July 2024.

6. Evaluation Criteria

Timely received proposals submitted by the tenderers will be examined, evaluated, and compared in accordance with the following criteria and the contract shall be awarded to the highest-ranked tenderer. The decision will be made according to the "Best Value for Money" principle.

- a. Quality of the proposal regarding implementation (40% of decision weight)
- b. References and existing network (40% of decision weight)

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c. Price (20% of decision weight)

An Evaluation Committee will be established. Each bid will be evaluated and ranked according to the criteria above. Compliance with the principles of transparency, non-discrimination, equal treatment, and absence of conflict of interest will be ensured.

The successful and unsuccessful tenderers will be informed in writing (via email) about the result of the award procedure. In case the winning tenderer is unable to enter the contract, EIT Manufacturing may decide to contract the supplier receiving the second-highest ranking. Proposals must be submitted by email within opening period of the request for proposal. All proposals received after the deadline will be rejected. In duly justified cases, however, no later than 1 calendar day before the original deadline, the submission deadline can be extended.

Upon request from the tenderer concerned, EIT Manufacturing will as quickly as possible, and in any event within 15 calendar days from receipt of a written request, inform:

- any unsuccessful candidate of the reasons for the rejection of its request to participate,
- any unsuccessful tenderer of the reasons for the rejection of its tender, including, if this is the case, its decision that the works, supplies or services do not meet the performance or functional requirements,
- any tenderer that has made an admissible tender of the characteristics and relative advantages of the tender selected as well as the name of the successful tenderer or the parties to the awarded contract,
- any tenderer that has made an admissible tender of the conduct and progress of negotiations and dialogue with tenderers.

The information referred to above may be withheld where the release of such information would be contrary to the public interest, would prejudice the legitimate commercial interests of an economic operator, or might prejudice fair competition between economic operators.

Should there be a suspicion that the provider will not be able to perform according to the price offered, EIT Manufacturing has the right to ask for explanations and may reject the tender where the evidence supplied does not satisfactorily account for the low level of price or cost proposed.

7. Complaint procedure

Tenderers believing that they have been harmed by an error or irregularity during the award process may file a complaint. Appeals shall be addressed to EIT Manufacturing only via the following email address <u>central@eitmanufacturing.eu</u>. The tenderers have 3 days to file their complaints from the date of receipt of notification of the results.

In your application to EIT Manufacturing the complainant shall explain what procedural aspects they consider having been violated along with any recommendations or remarks. Such claims need to be supported with data and facts and relevant documentation. An appeal whose sole purpose is to obtain a

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second evaluation for no reason other than that the complainant disagrees with the final award decision is to be rejected.

8. Negotiations & Clarifications

Negotiations can be held in the following cases:

- if it is identified that the scope of services issued by EIT Manufacturing is not detailed enough, incomplete or some areas are lacking crucial information to complete the procedure for direct awards
- if EIT Manufacturing has the intention to reduce the offered prices to find the best value for money
- if all submitted prices are above the planned budget and it is in everyone's interest to finish the procedure with success in that case, price negotiation can take place. During price negotiation, all tenderers are called to lower their prices by the same deadline in written form

EIT Manufacturing can organize as many rounds of negotiation as needed during the procedure to reach the highest quality of proposals and the best price.

Whenever possible, the negotiations should be carried out in writing, however, in special cases, video conferences or even live can be organized. EIT Manufacturing also reserves the right to invite 5 of the tenderers to an individual meeting before the final award of the contract to clarify details and ambiguities. In case of obvious or perceived errors or omissions in the RfP, Tenderers can request additional information or clarifications by the deadline provided in the above timeframe through an email to central@eitmanufacturing.eu.

Upon receipt of the bids, they will be reviewed, and additional details will be requested from the tenderers as needed. The requests as well as the answers are to be submitted written by e-mail. Where information or documentation to be submitted by tenderers is incomplete or erroneous or where specific documents are missing, EIT Manufacturing staff may request the party concerned to submit, supplement, clarify or complete the relevant information or documentation within 2 days.

Bid preparation costs are not reimbursable and must be borne by the tenderers.

EIT Manufacturing owns all bids received in this RFP. Proprietary information of vendors in the bids will be kept strictly confidential. The offers as well as the contract may be submitted for audits.

9. Contract

The final award does not yet constitute the contract, nor this tender constitutes a promise to contract. The Contract will be concluded at the time of signature by the Supplier(s) and EIT Manufacturing. The winning supplier will be sent the contract to be signed (indicating the deadline by which the signed contract should be returned to EIT Manufacturing). The reimbursement will be based on a mutually agreed schedule; it will be detailed in the contract. The contract will be awarded until 31 December 2024. Annual renewal of the contract is possible if targets are met. The tenderer agrees that the total value of the contract to be signed





with EIT Manufacturing will in no way exceed the bid (the amount contained in the offer) of the tenderer. An exception is made for travel expenses outside of Ukraine, which are additionally reimbursed depending on the expense and prior approval.

The awarded supplier will be requested to sign Standard Contractual Clauses (SCC) if no other GDPRcompliant safeguards exist, and the supplier is located in a country for which the EU commission has not issued an adequacy decision.

10. Cancellation of the proposal procedure

In the event of cancellation of the proposal procedure, EIT Manufacturing will notify tenderers of the cancellation. In no event shall EIT Manufacturing be liable for any damages whatsoever including, without limitation, damages for loss of profits, in any way connected with the cancellation of a proposal procedure, even if EIT Manufacturing has been advised of the possibility of damages. The tenderer shall take all measures to prevent any situation where the impartial and objective implementation of the contract is compromised for reasons involving economic interest, political or national affinity, family or emotional ties or any other shared interest ('conflict of interests'). S/he should inform the EIT Manufacturing team immediately if there is any change in the above circumstances at any stage during the implementation of the tasks.

The supplier may not be an EIT Manufacturing Core or Associate Partner. Any bid from such an economic operator may be rejected. EIT Manufacturing Network Partner are eligible to bid.

Tenderers will be excluded if:

- a. they are being wound up, are having their affairs administered by the courts, have entered into an arrangement with creditors, have suspended business activities, are the subject of proceedings concerning those matters, or are in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations; they have been convicted of an offence concerning their professional conduct by a judgment which has the force of res judicata;
- b. they have been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the EIT Manufacturing can justify;
- c. they have not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes by the legal provisions of the country in which they are established or any other country of the EU;
- d. they have been the subject of a judgment which has the force of res judicata for fraud, corruption, involvement in a criminal organization or any other illegal activity detrimental to the EU's financial interests;
- e. following a procurement procedure or grant award procedure financed by the EU budget, they have been declared in serious breach of contract for failure to comply with their contractual obligations.

The tenderers must not be in a situation of a conflict of interest, and they have sufficient economic and financial capacity, technical and professional capacity and legal and regulatory capacity to perform the requested services. Additional evidence or declarations might be requested by the contracting authority.

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EIT Manufacturing reserves the right to suspend or cancel the procedure, where the award procedure proves to have been subject to substantial errors, irregularities, conflict of interest or fraud. If substantial errors, irregularities, conflict of interest or fraud are discovered after the award of the Contract, EIT Manufacturing may refrain from concluding the Contract.
