The proposal must be built on the results of a successfully closed project funded by a Factories of the Future (FoF)/Made in Europe (MiE) call under Horizon Europe Framework Programme

Topic #1

••• First-Time-Right Manufacturing

Get things right the first time, rather than relying on rework and correction to achieve quality

Each proposal must focus on one of the listed challenges:

- Simulation and Digital Twins
- Advanced analytics
- Real-time Monitoring and Sensors
- Predictive Maintenance
- Artificial Intelligent (Machine Learning)
- Automation

Topic #2

••• End-of-Lifecycle management

Ensure products at the end of their useful life that are either repurposed for their next lifecycle or disposed of in an environmentally friendly manner.

Each proposal must focus on one of the listed challenges:

- Circular design products
- Product reuse
- Easy disassembly and recycling
- Frameworks and platforms for circularity


Applicant

 SMEs, large enterprises, research institutions and universities established in one of the Member States or associated Countries to Horizon Europe and the low- and middle-income countries



Consortium

- At least 3 legal entities independent from each other and established in countries covered by at least 2 different EIT Manufacturing ICs:
 - At least #1 independent legal entity established in a Member State;
 - At least #2 other independent legal entities, established in a Member States or Associated Countries

Available budget and co-funding

- The duration of the Project is months 18 months (May 25 October 26)
- The total budget allocated to this call is **EUR 5 000 000**. The amounts will be allocated according to the following:

- Each partner is requested to contribute with eligible expenditures at least equal to 10% of the project total budget
- Activity proposals submitted to this call are expected to have a minimum cofunding rate of 33%



Project designing Eligible costs

- Personnel costs
- Subcontracting
- Puchase costs: Travel, Equipment (depreciation), Consumables
- Other costs: internally invoiced goods & services
- Indirect costs: 25% of eligible direct costs (subcontracting excluded)






Documentation to be submitted

- Business Plan (pdf only)
- GANTT chart (pdf only)
- SDGs template (excel file)


Any documentation missing, incomplete or sent after the deadline, will be inadmissible



Contents

The proposals should cover the following contents:

- Objectives and novelty
- Contribution to EIT Manufacturing KPIs, Business Plan, SGDs survey, Dissemination strategy
- Workplan, Deliverables, Budget
- Outcomes according to the selected Topic, Skills Development Strategy, Financial Sustainability
- Pan-European dimension, RIS aspects



Main outcome per Project




#1 innovation introduced on the market

Proposing a higher target than the minimum required, but still credible and justified, will be positively evaluated



Mandatory deliverables

The Services Agreement

The Services Agreement covers services to the consortium during the implementation of the activity and offers the possibility for the Business Owner to receive additional support after the end of the activity.



- Matchmaking with any stakeholders that may be interested in the activity (Businesses, Research Centres etc.)
- Participation in dissemination or business events
- Further matchmaking with any stakeholders that may be interested in the activity to further expand it and fully monetize it at the pan-European level
- Access to insights from EIT
 Manufacturing and its network
 of experts on topics related to
 the activity

Payment conditions:

- **EUR 50 000**
- Revenue sharing (min 5%) for 5 years

- The proposal must cover one of the following topics:

Topic #1: First-Time-Right Manufacturing Topic #2: End-of-Lifecycle management

- At least 3 legal entities independent from each other and established in countries covered by at least 2 different EIT Manufacturing ICs:
 - At least 1 independent legal entity established in a Member State;
 - At least 2 other independent legal entities, established in a Member States or Associated Countries
- The Business Owner is the **responsible** for the commercialisation plan of the solution and its execution
- The Services Agreement covers services to the consortium during and after the end of the activity. A payment of EUR 50 000 will be triggered at the end of the activity, as well as a revenue-sharing mechanism for a duration of 5 years (min 5%)
