About the position:

The Corporate Communication Manager will support the Communication Director and Management Team as well as the EIT Manufacturing organisation in developing and implementing the EIT Manufacturing's communication strategy.

The Corporate Communication Manager will help coordinate, plan and prioritize the communication related activities organised by the headquarters. This role will be responsible for managing and developing central communication tools and activities such as the digital channels, i.e., social media and website. Corporate Communication Manager will also be accountable for developing a comprehensive media relations strategy, content production and will support main corporate events and the roll-out of strategic projects and campaigns.

Missions and key Accountabilities:

- Support the implementation of the EIT Manufacturing's communication strategy and the yearly
 planning, activity monitoring and timely reporting, with the goal to make EIT Manufacturing's vision
 and mission tangible and engaging to its key stakeholders.
- Support the Communication Director with the daily operations, covering both regular communication activities, and the so-called dissemination activities, i.e., sharing and amplifying the KIC's results.
- Support EIT Manufacturing in its new positioning as a service organisation concerning messaging, channels and tools among others.
- Support to tailor messaging and communication in alignment with EU affairs team on policy topics.
 Eg. Press releases, news items, opinion papers.
- Contribute and work in alignment with the Communication team in the whole organisation including the regional offices (Impact Centers).
- Directly manage a small team (1-2 people).





Qualifications and experience:

- University degree in relevant field e.g. communications, public relations, journalism. Specialisation in digital communication (web, social media) and/or press relations would be a plus.
- Minimum 5-7 years' experience in driving communication on global/European level.
- Outstanding written, oral and presentation skills in English. Command of French and other European languages would be plus.
- Proven skills in innovative, modern and digital communications design and roll-out, including creating content and the choice of channels.
- Familiarity with CMS platforms (e.g. WordPress) and knowledge of basic web design principles.
- Ability to convert scientific and/or technical concepts to simple and compelling content for diverse audiences, including press releases, social media posts, and executive speeches.
- Experience in developing and maintaining relationships with media outlets, journalists, and influencers, ensuring positive and strategic media coverage.

Skills:

- Command in English and knowledge of French and other European languages is a plus.
- Demonstrated proficiency in creative and contemporary communication strategies, and channel selection
- Excellent organisational skills and ability to meet the deadlines.
- Strong team spirit, proactiveness, autonomy and trustworthiness.
- Sense of ownership with proven record of delivering results.
- Ability to manage multiple streams of work in a fast-paced environment.
- Self-motivated, flexible and a team player.
- Analytical skills and detail oriented.
- International experience, background in manufacturing or technology sectors are a plus.
