About the position:

The Operations Project Officer will report to the Operations Project Manager.

• PMO general processes (in the context of the above key accountabilities)

- o Contributing to the preparation of the reports and deliverables submitted to the regulator of EIT Manufacturing and ensure the consistency between contributions from the staff

- Minimum of 2 years' experience as project manager with a focus on managing and reporting EU funded projects (especially from Horizon Europe)
- Prior experience with Cascade Funding (FSTP) grants and/or EIT is a plus
- Willingness and ability to go beyond business as usual, improve processes and propose new ideas to automate as much as possible all processes
